Easy, right?



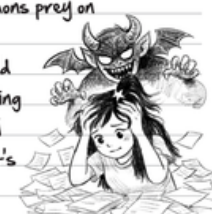

La, la, la, la, la... I'm not looking up. Not even a little. La, la, la...

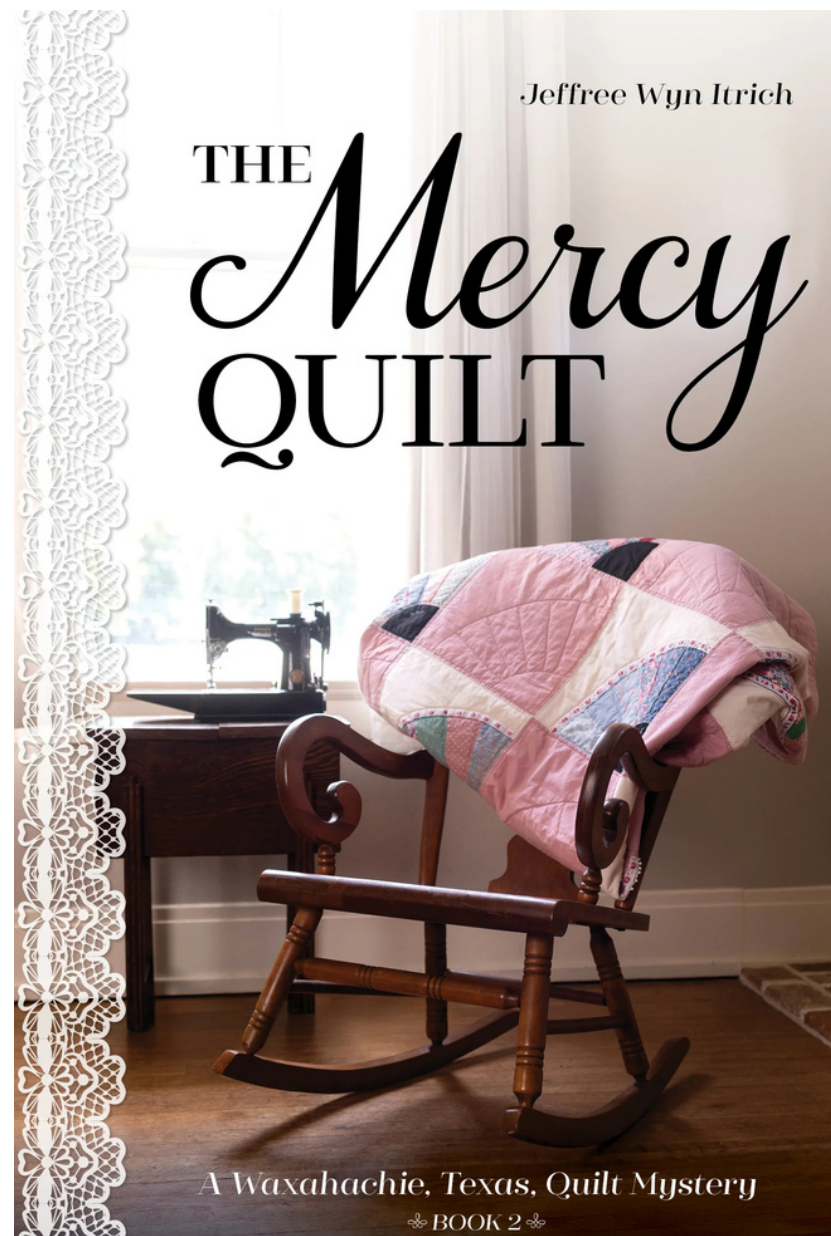
Uff! My teacher called on me. He asked if I could tell him what demons prey on, and I couldn't. I couldn't say a single word! But do you know who did?
